Bright Starts Co-operative Early Learning Centre Inc. is getting ready for a fun filled summer with the registration of our Summer Camp Program. Our Summer Camp Program is geared towards children who will be **entering into or have currently graduated from Junior or Senior Kindergarten**. Summer Camp runs on a weekly basis from July 4, 2017 to September 1, 2017, 7:30 am – 5:30 pm and will operate out of our multi-purpose room. A nutritious lunch, morning and afternoon snack will be provided. We are in the midst of planning and confirming our camp adventures - including field trips, guests, craft activities, swimming, special events and more. A detailed calendar of activities will be available shortly.

Summer Camp is available for registration in **week blocks only** and our weekly fee is \$230.00. There are 26 spaces available each week.

Summer Camp Registration will be offered to families currently registered in our child care programs from February 1st – 10th, 2017. Registration will open to the general public on a first-come-first-serve basis starting the week of February 13, 2017.

Payment Policy:

A postdated cheque is required for each individual week that your child is registered. Requests for cancellation must be submitted to the office in writing by Friday, March 31st, 2017. No Refunds will be issued after that date, regardless of our ability to fill your spot. Payments that are returned for insufficient funds will be charged back to your account along with a \$25.00 service fee.

To register your child for Summer Camp, please indicate the weeks that you are interested in, on the attached form. When submitting, please include a postdated cheque dated for the Monday of each week you are registering your child. **Registration Forms will not be accepted without payment.** Once you've submitted the attached form and payment, you will receive a full registration package to complete.
